

On May 24th, Manitoba Education and Early Childhood Learning announced the suspension of the Grade 12 English Language Arts Provincial Test. There were concerns with one of the readings contained within the test materials. On May 28th and May 29th additional direction was provided by the province regarding new expectations for the assessment. This included:

- Students having the opportunity to write a final assessment prior to June 21st
- Providing opportunities that were similar across schools within a division
- Maintaining the 20% weighting and reporting on the provincial report card
- The format and scheduling of the test can be altered to meet local needs and the test does not need to be written over four days

MEECL provided schools with additional materials from the January 2024 test for schools to use if needed.

On May 29th a TEAMS call was held with the five high schools and one colony school who had students writing the assessment in June. Two of the schools were using previous years test materials to structure their final assessment and four of the schools will be using the January 2024 materials. Schools indicated they were comfortable with the process and were confident the new criteria from MEECL could be achieved. Thank you to our school teams for their flexibility and quick adjustments to facilitate the assessment.
