Participants will be able to provide feedback regarding the public's priorities and where taxpayers would like the division to spend money as it relates to student education and budget initiatives.

The meeting typically includes a budget presentation and provides opportunity for questions from the public. Stakeholder input will help guide the board's decisions and actions.

Sunrise will hold a draft budget meeting on the 2024-25 budget next February with the passed budget forwarded to the province for approval by the end of

Last March, Sunrise approved the operating expenditures for the 2023-24 school year in the amount of \$74.4 million; an increase of \$2 million (3.2 per cent).

The area of increases and their portion related to the increase to the budget was insurance (seven per cent), trasnsportation fuel costs (10 per cent), interest costs (19 per cent), salaray and benefits (46 per cent).


