



Public sector organizations are required to have accessibility plans and update them every two years, while private sector organizations and non-profit organizations are not required to have them.

The Sunrise Accessibility Plan was most recently updated in March 2022 and can be found on our website at:

The accessibility legislation outlines priorities in five accessibility areas:

- -The Accessible Customer Service Standard
- -The Accessible Information and Communications Standard
- -The Accessible Built Environment Standard
- -The Employment Accessibility Standard
- -The Accessible Transportation Standard

The Sunrise Accessibility Plan works to address barriers in all standards in a proactive way as they arise. For example, each school and divisional site has at least one accessible entrance to the building even though that is not a legislated requirement at this time. The status of other proactive and required actions can be found on page 9 of the SSD Accessibility Plan.

Certain standards have sector-specific deadlines set out by statute. The compliance deadlines for school divisions thus far are as follows:

Development of Accessibility Plan SSD Compliance December 13, 2016	by December 31, 2016
Customer Service Accessibility Training SSD Compliance October 2017	by November 1, 2017
Accessible Emergency Response Planning SSD Compliance annually since fall 2019	by May 1, 2020
Accessible Hiring Practice Training SSD Compliance since February 2022	by May 1, 2022

The upcoming actions for Sunrise School Division are as follows:

- -continue annual training modules for new staff or all staff as required (September 2022)
- -review the Accessibility Plan with Administrators and Managers (September 2022)
- -review and update the SSD Accessibility Plan (By March 2024)
- -prepare for the implementation of the next legislated standard around information sharing and communication digitally, in-print or through technology or people

(By May 1, 2024)
