Panthers Keep Winning

The Pinawa Panthers are within striking distance of first place in the Price Division following a 6-2 win over the Powerview-Sagkeeng Wild on Dec. 6. They are three points out of first place.

Connor Bruyere gave the Wild the lead at 2:33 of the first period thanks to a pass from Syllas Courchene. Kane McMurren tied it just over a minute later to send the teams into intermission with a 1-1 score.

It took only 11 seconds for Lachlan Cuthbert to give the Panthers a 2-1 lead in the second frame, but Chevy Bruyere tied it again at 3:47. Panther Jaedys Dancy broke the tie at 8:49. Pinawa added three in the final 20 minutes to make the final 6-2. Cuthbert scored a pair to complete his hat trick. Jakob Morgan closed the scoring at 17:37.

Pinawa will host Murdoch MacKay on Dec. 15 at 5 p.m. in Lac du Bonnet and visit the Habs on Dec. 18. They close out 2023 by hosting the Wild on Dec. 20 at 4 p.m.

Wild Lose Three

The Powerview-Sagkeeng Wild began the week with a 3-1 loss against Murdoch MacKay on Dec. 4. Chevy Bruyere scored in the first period, but the Wild surrendered three goals in the final 20 minutes.

Following the 6-2 loss to the Panthers on Dec. 6, the Wild visited the Wind-

sor Park Royals on Dec. 8. Connor Bruyere's two goals had the Wild up 2-1 late in the second period, but the Royals scored two late one to take a 3-2 lead into the third period.

Jaden Swampy tied the game at 1:44 of the third period, but the Royals won two minutes into overtime.

The Wild host the Panthers on Dec. 20 at 4 p.m.

Sabres Lose Heartbreaker

While the Springfield Sabres gave the first-place Gabrielle Roy-Pointe des Chenes Cavaliers all they could handle on Dec. 5, they ultimately fell 5-4 in overtime.

Parker Fazio opened the scoring at 6:12 of the first period to give the host Sabres an early 1-0 lead. That lasted less than three minutes as the Cavs tied it up at 8:41 to send the teams into the break with the score 1-1.

Les Cavaliers scored the first two goals of the second period, but Max Sholdra added a goal with 59 seconds left to make it 3-2 after two periods. It took only 20 seconds into fresh ice for Cam Osborne to tie the game at 3-3, and Brady Rach gave the Sabres a 4-3 lead eight minutes later. That only lasted one minute as the Cavaliers scored on the power play to tie the game at four. They won it at 3:18 of overtime.

Results of the Dec. 12 game were unavailable at press time. Springfield hits

the road for games on Dec. 13 and 15 before hosting Leo Remillard at 4 p.m. on Dec. 19. They close out 2023 at St. John's Ravenscourt on Dec. 21.

Barons Lose Nailbiter

Two late goals sent the École Edward Schreyer Barons to a 4-3 loss against the Louis Riel Voyageurs on Dec. 5.

Down 1-0 midway through the second period, the Barons scored two goals in 26 seconds to jump ahead 2-1. Kane Zarichanski and Miles Armit were the marksmen. The Voyageurs

tied it 26 seconds later to send the teams into the final break tied 2-2.

Brady Szajewski gave the Barons a 3-2 lead at 5:19 of the third. That score held until the final seconds, as the Voyageurs tied the game with only 17 seconds remaining. They completed the comeback at 2:15 into extra hockey.

The Barons close out 2023 with three home games at the Sun Gro Centre on Dec. 14 against Kildonan East at 4 p.m., Dec. 18 against Lorette at 3:30 p.m. and Dec. 21 against Warren at 2 p.m.
