



January is the month that schools in Sunrise begin the kindergarten registration
process in all our schools. Families will have the option to register their child for
kindergarten through our online process or may visit the school on a chosen date
should they prefer to register in-person. Registering children for kindergarten
early helps the division staff appropriately, complete readiness assessments, and
invite families to kindergarten orientations well before the start of the school year.

Kindergarten registration week is Monday, January 29th to Friday, February 2nd. Dates for in-person registration will be communicated and publicized by each school.
