- reading, writing and numeracy info.

Information is Used to Create Classroom Profiles

- look for trends
- responsive teaching Strategies are applied

Questionnaires

- each student/each class
- minimize assumptions
- encourages selfadvocacy
- strengthens relationships

- 60% of Staff in Semester 1
- 80% of Staff in Semester 2
