of July in Winnipeg. AK Soccer Academy opened group stage play with a 6-1 victory over FC Northwest on July 18 in a 3-1 victory over Winnipeg South End United.

In the semis, AK Soccer Academy dropped Winnipeg Phoenix FC 9-0 to earn their spot in the finals against FC Northwest.
