#### **Hiring of New Bus Drivers**


Our success is based on hiring new drivers at a steady pace – since the end of last school year we have onboarded 7 new drivers and have an additional 5 waiting for their road tests at the end of October.

We have experienced some churn with drivers leaving for full time positions elsewhere and we have a number who have been off for medical reasons. Our average has been 5 – 7 drivers off every day since the start of school.



### **New Advertising Strategy**

We have purchased advertising space at a number of Arena's in the Sunrise area in the hope of attracting the parent demographics to our bus driving team.



## **Non-eligible Students**

Most of the requests come from students in the walk-zone, either on the outer edges of the zone or live in the walk-zone and have a daycare on a bus route.

This year we had 35 students request busing and we were able to accept 15 – last year we had more requests and were able to accept a higher percentage of students.

By area: Oakbank – 15 requests, 7 approved

Dugald – 1 requests, 1 approved Gillis – 11 requests, 1 approved

Beausejour – 8 requests, 6 approved



#### **Bus update**

Our 7 new buses are in the process of arriving to our Dealer in Steinbach – 4 have arrived and 3 are on route. We should have some to our garage for two-way radio and GPS equipment installation by last week of October.

We ordered 3 - 77 passenger, 2 - 65 passenger & 2 - 53 passenger – all gas models.
